Background:

Due to a request from members of the Interagency Review Team (IRT) – we are issuing this Addendum.

Scope of Work Change:

A. Add the following:

II. C.1.h. Fish Surveys

- (i) Conduct fish surveys in accordance with the Fish Assemblages Section IV (pages 31-33) of the Fairfax County DPWES Policies and Procedures Memorandum No. SWPD19-03:
https://www.fairfaxcounty.gov/publicworks/sites/publicworks/files/assets/documents/pdf/publications/stream_assessment_sop.pdf.
- (ii) Perform surveys on three (3) – 100m long reaches in both Snakeden and Glade streams; one near the bottom of each restored stream area, one in the general vicinity of the 300-acre minimum drainage area specified by Fairfax County, and one generally in between.
- (iii) Surveys shall be conducted in the Spring and Fall of each of the six (6) monitoring years, with data compilations included in each annual monitoring report and the final report

B. Delete Section II.C.2.b. (x) Fish

C. **Revise the Due Date** on the Cover, in the SOAF and in III.A. from May 15 to **May 29, 2020** to allow additional time for both this Scope of Work Change and for delays related to Stay-at-Home work rules.

D. General Note: There are three (3) batches of Q and A's that have been issued to Registered Bidders – If you are working on a proposal response, you should register as some of these Q and A's may be helpful to you.
